Cover page

Includes student number, student name-surname, date of report, supervisor name-surname and jury member names-surnames. The background of the cover page of the report should be white.

1. Introduction

General information about the topic and the proposed contribution.

2. Previous Semester Work

A general summary about what was done in the previous semester.

(For the first Follow-up Report: Previous work may not exist.

<u>For the second, third, ... reports</u>: a brief "summary" of Literature Review should be included in the reports with an explanation about what was done in the previous semester.)

3. Current Semester Work

A detailed explanation about what was done in the current semester.

(<u>For the first Follow-up Report</u>: A detailed explanation about Literature Review should be included in the report.)

4. Future Work

A brief explanation about what will be done in the next semester.

5. List of Publications

A list of publications that were published/submitted/in preparation (if any)

6. References

The list of references used in the thesis work

7. Appendix

Includes papers/articles published/submitted/in preparation (if any))

PhD Follow-up Report Format

The report should be written in Times New Roman with font size 12. The section titles should be bold, figure captions should be below the figures and table captions should be above the tables.

The minimum and the maximum number of pages of the report should be between 10 and 20 pages.
